<u>Unity Bog removal of birch saplings</u>. This regeneration work has been planned in conjunction with Natural England who look after this SSSI. Bogs are scarce and special ecosystems, and also carbon stores. The birch take up the water needed to maintain the bog and their removal has been advised whilst Natural England plans its next steps.
